This online service provides an up-to-date listing of people who are ready and willing to work when you need them. The RewardingWork.org Directory is sponsored by the **Rhode Island Executive Office of Health and Human Services**.

### Find the Right Person

The Directory lets you find people willing to work part-time or full-time, days, nights, overnights, weekends – whenever you need them. You can also indicate if you need workers who:

- Will work with infants and toddlers, school-age children or teens
- Is able to provide respite care
- Has specialized skills or certifications
- Drives or has a car
- Speaks your language

Since it's online, the Directory is always available and always up-to-date!

### How the Directory Works

Using the Directory is simple:

- Visit **www.RewardingWork.org** to establish a password-protected account.
- Residents of Rhode Island with disabilities who participate in **PersonalChoice, Respite or PASS** may be eligible to receive a free long-term subscription to Rewarding Work. To learn more, contact your Advisement Agency or CEDARR Family Centers for additional information.
- Once you are registered, search the Directory for available workers.
- Contact the people who meet your needs.
